# Accra, Ghana

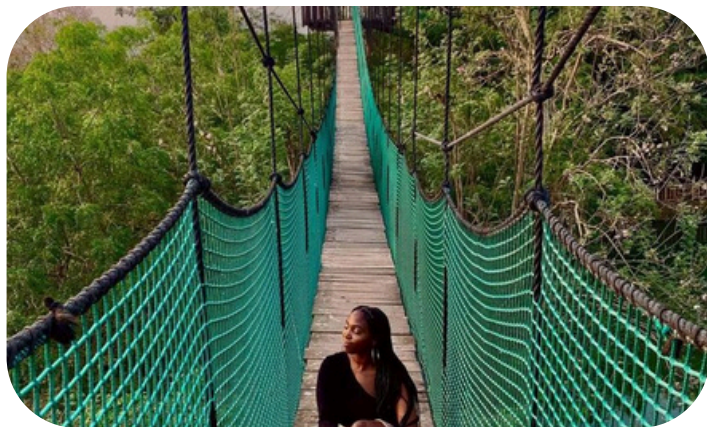
